





Poll Worker *Paid*




Poll Watcher Kit

- 1. Wear certificate around your neck (lanyard) or pinned to jacket.
- 2. No political clothing, paraphernalia, talk. You will be asked to leave.
- 3. No photos or video recordings of voters.
- 4. Bring a notebook and two pens to take notes.
- 5. Bring your cell phone and a charger.
- 6. Be <u>specific</u> on Poll Observer Incident Report.
- 7. Bring phone numbers for Legal Counsel and the RNC War Room to report election integrity problems.
- 8. Pack a lunch and a bottle of water.
- 9. Bring folding chair to sit at poll in case one is not offered.
- 10. Bring precinct voter lists so you'll know who voted and who is eligible to vote at the precinct.
- 11. Smile!

Drag and Drop

- "Strikers" work with the Poll Watcher to know who voted.
- "Strikers" are provided a voter list to "strike" off names as Republican voters cast their vote.
- "Strikers" check each hour, call, or forward the names to the Phone Bank of those citizens who haven't voted.
- Phone Banks are setup and organized to call voters to remind them to go to their poll to vote.
